Fee Schedule

Sewer service charges are designed to derive the annual revenue requirements necessary to fund the operation of the sewer collection system as well as to derive these revenue requirements equitably from each class of user in accordance with their differing demands placed upon the system.

Rates for user classes A and B below were determined in a study entitled, *Sewer Financial Plan, Rate Analysis, and Connection Charge Update*, dated June 12, 2007, by Bartle Wells Associates.

Accounts with broken meters will use the account's average water consumption.

If an account's sewer flow is significantly less than the average for the user class due to on-site use, then an engineering estimate of sewer flow may be used.

As actual discharge loading data becomes available, rates for individual customers may be amended to reflect this actual data each calendar quarter.

**B. VACANCY CREDIT**

Vacancy credit may be granted only for unmetered residential accounts, and solely on the following terms and conditions:

- (1) A written request is received from the customer.
- (2) Payment in full of the current utility bill.
- (3) Water service is turned off.
- (4) The credit amount shall be \$100% of the flat charge.

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**C. SECURITY DEPOSIT**

In addition to penalties provided for in the Municipal Code for delinquent payment, the City may require a security deposit in an amount not to exceed the highest monthly charge during the prior 12 months.
